1. ESSAY. In no more than 1000 words answer the following:

2. GRADE POINT AVERAGE. Please attach your most recent transcript. If you are a continuing college student, attach a college transcript. Students entering college as a new student must attach a high school transcript.

3. COMPETITIVE HONORS. List honors or awards you have received through school or community events. Examples include: Student of the Month, Most Valuable Player, Talent Award, and many other honors. These awards can be given by a variety of entities including clubs, schools, honor societies, sports groups, arts organizations and civic associations.

4. ACTIVITIES. Provide a list of school or community activities. Include membership in school, civic or church organizations. Volunteer activities such as mentoring, voter registration, food drives and other activities should be listed.

5. LEADERSHIP. List Leadership positions you have held. Leadership takes many forms including holding office, serving on a board or committee or leading a project.

6. TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION (Required). These letters can be up to one year old (they do not have to be new or original letters) but should speak to how long and in what capacity the person has known you, your potential or abilities and why you deserve a scholarship.
